PROJECT NO. 1

Type of Approval Requested: IMPOSE and USE

Project Title: Construction of Snow Removal Equipment (SRE) Building

Project Description: The project was to construct a 75'x100' metal building to house snow removal equipment. The building has one large open bay and houses an Oshkosh snow blower, a motor grader and a rotary broom along with other equipment and supplies used to maintain the snow removal equipment. Project began in June 2013 and is complete by June of 2014.

PROJECT NO. 2

Type of Approval Requested: IMPOSE and USE

Project Title: Rehabilitation of Parking Area for Overflow Parking

Project Description: The Project was completed in fall of 2017 due to need for additional parking for travelers. Parking area is approximately 75FT X 300FT, 32 new spaces were added. Handicap ramps were added, sidewalks and curb & gutters and a fog seal on existing asphalt to make the area usable for the overflow parking.

PROJECT NO. 3

Type of Approval Requested: IMPOSE and USE

Project Title: Security Upgrade to meet the TSA Requirements-security upgrades to meet CAT III

Project Description: In order to meet the requirements TSA made essential in their letter to ROW November 27, 2017 to upgrade security at ROW, gates, doors, access controls and system identification upgrades were necessary. The project was started in fall of 2017 and will be completed in February of 2018.

PROJECT NO. 4

Type of Approval Requested: IMPOSE and USE

Project Title: Rehabilitate Taxiway K, Design and Construction

Project Description: Taxiway K is a connector taxiway between hangar 91 ramp and Runway 3/21. The existing Taxiway K is in the Safety Area of 3/21. The design & construction will relocate this connector out of the RSA for Runway 3/21 the new connector is (1300 feet X 35 feet). Taxiway K was designed and construction was completed in May of 2018.

ROW PFC Amount Requested- \$ 27,259

PROJECT NO. 5

Type of Approval Requested: IMPOSE and USE

Project Title: Rehabilitate Runway 17/35, Design and Construction

Project Description: The project will include the design, bid and construction for the rehabilitation of the existing surface of the Runway 17-35. The portion of the runway to be rehabilitated is 100' X 1500' asphalt surface that is experiencing rutting and will be studied and evaluated to determine the runway requirements for the construction portion of project. Project started in the Fall of 2018, construction was completed in December of 2018.

Type of Approval Requested: IMPOSE and USE

Project Title: Terminal Building Expansion- A Terminal Feasibility, Capacity and Conceptual Study

Project Description: This project will assemble a schematic design document consisting of existing plans and documents of the present-day terminal. The project will incorporate information from stakeholders (City, ROW administration/ maintenance, TSA, air carriers and other users), on needs, bottlenecks, handicap problem areas, evaluated for security needs...ROW desires to take a good look at the overall terminal needs so they can have a good graphical depiction before they move forward with a terminal expansion.

Type of Approval Requested: IMPOSE and USE

Project Title: PFC Administration Costs

Project Description: The project identifies the administrative costs associated with notifications, justifications, meetings, and filing the appropriate application and information with FAA and the carriers with respect to collecting and using PFC monies for the capital improvement projects addressed in this Application No. 6 and Amend Applications 4 at the Roswell International Air Center. The services are to start in the fall of 2017 and to be complete by the spring of 2018.
