

ORDINANCE NO. 01-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL RESTRICTING OPERATION OF TRUCKS AND OTHER COMMERCIAL VEHICLES ON CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, certain residential streets within the City have experienced substantial heavy truck traffic, and such traffic is considered a hazard for residents along the streets; and

WHEREAS, the subject street is not and was not intended to function as an avenue for heavy trucks or other vehicles of similar size; and

WHEREAS, the subject street is described as follows:
East Country Club Road, from North Main Street to North Atkinson Avenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, that:

Section 1. Section 24-8 of the Roswell City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

(4) The portion of East Country Club, from North Main Street to North Atkinson Avenue is determined to be a primarily residential area.

Section 2. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of ordinance heretofore repealed.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.


Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall be effective five days following its publication or such time later that appropriate signs have been erected indicating the ordinance's provisions.
