

ORDINANCE NO. 10-09

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, PROVIDING THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, BE AMENDED BY REVOCATION OF THE EXISTING CHAPTER 13 (AND REPEAL OF ORDINANCES 13-20, 13-22, AND 02-7), FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION, IN ITS ENTIRETY, ADOPTING THE 2009 EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE, WITH AMENDMENTS AS DETAILED IN EXHIBIT "A".**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to ensure that the adopted Fire Code is compatible with the 2009 New Mexico Commercial Building Code, the 2009 New Mexico Residential Building Code, and the 2009 New Mexico Existing Building Code, all of which have been lawfully adopted by the City of Roswell: and


**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that the public interest will best be served by adoption of certain standards and codes of the National Fire Protection Association and the adoption of the 2009 Edition of the International Fire Code, with amendments, appendices, fire lane requirements and fee schedules, as listed in Exhibit "A".

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO that:**

- (A) Chapter 13 of the Roswell City Code is amended as follows: (See Text)
- (B) All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.
- (C) If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or non-enforceable, the invalidity or non-enforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.
- (D) This ordinance shall be effective after five (5) days following its publication as required by law.
