ORDINANCE No. 234

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION I. OF ORDINANCE No. 161 OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL.

Be It Ordained By the ~~City~~ Council Of The City of Roswell:

Section I. That Section I. of Ordinance No. 161 of the City of Roswell, passed and approved the 3rd day of September, 1908, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Section I. That from and after the passage and taking effect of this Ordinance the sidewalk curb line on Main Street in the City of Roswell be and the same is hereby fixed and established to extend uniformly Thirteen (13)

feet from the property line on each side of said Main Street, ~~throughout the entire length of said Street,~~ ^{between Alameda ~~Street~~ and Fifth Streets}

that the sidewalk or curb line shall be Thirteen (13) feet

~~wide on each side of said Street"~~ ^{main} ~~between said Alameda ~~Street~~ and Fifth Streets~~ ^{and north of Fifth Street}
The curb line on said ^{main} Street south of Alameda ~~Street~~ ^{Street}

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the above Ordinance of the City of Roswell as amended hereby are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
