ORDINANCE NO.....

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING HOUSES WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL TO BE SCREENED AGAINST FLIES AND OTHER INSECTS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL:-

Section 1. It is hereby made the duty of every owner, agent or person having in charge ~~of~~ any dwelling house, tent house or other building or structure of any character used as a dwelling, whether occupied by such owner, agent or by tenant, immediately upon the passage of this ordinance, to properly screen and keep screened, all doors, windows and openings in all such dwelling houses, tent houses and other buildings or structures of any character used as dwellings, with fly screen, with meshes of sufficient fineness to prevent flies and other germ bearing insects from entering such dwelling houses, tent houses, or structures or other buildings, of any character used as dwellings.

Section 2. No notice, other than the legal publication of this ordinance, shall be necessary; and every such owner, agent or person having charge of any such dwelling house, tent house or other building, or structure of any character used as a dwelling, who shall fail to comply with the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined in any sum not less than \$10.00, nor more than \$100. or be imprisoned in the City jail, subject to labor, for a period of not less than ten days, nor more than ninety days, in the discretion of the court having jurisdiction of the cause; and each day's violation of this ordinance shall be deemed and constitute a separate offense, and punishable as above provided.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its legal publication, and all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
