

ORDINANCE NO. 244


An Ordinance Repealing Ordinance No. 239 of the City of Roswell, N.M. Entitled " AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT VEHICLES, INCLUDING AUTOMOBILES, FROM BEING ALLOWED TO STAND ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF THIRD STREET," approved February 10th, 1912.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL:

Section 1. That Ordinance #239 of the City of Roswell, entitled " An ordinance to prohibit vehicles, including automobiles, from being allowed to stand on certain portions of Third Street", approved February 10th, 1912, be, and the same hereby is, repealed.


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and legal publication.
