

ORDINANCE No. 304

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE ^{the} ~~to~~ CARRYING ON AND CONDUCTING
OF THEATRICALS, SHOWS AND OTHER FORMS OF AMUSEMENT.

Be It Ordained By The City Council Of The City Of Roswell:

Section 1. That no license to operate, run, conduct or carry on any Theatrical, Moving Picture or other Show or amusement, shall authorize the licensee to make, give, conduct or carry on any exhibition or amusement, theatrical or otherwise, on Sunday, and if it appear to the City Council that any person, firm or corporation so licensed shall give, carry on or conduct any amusement, Moving Picture Show or other Exhibition, Theatrical or otherwise ^{on Sunday} they shall immediately revoke the license, and the person, firm or corporation so offending, shall, upon conviction, be punished as herein provided, the same as if no license had been issued.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any of the terms or provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00, or by imprisonment in the City or County Jail, not less than five (5) nor more than sixty (60) days, and each day that any of the provisions of this Ordinance are violated, shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, and this Ordinance shall be in full force from and after five (5) days after its publication, as provided by Law.
