

ORDINANCE NO. 314

AN ORDINANCE re-establishing the curb lines on Missouri Avenue, Lea Avenue, Kentucky Avenue and Pennsylvania Avenue, in the City of Roswell, New Mexico.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL:-

Section 1. That there is hereby established and created a uniform curb line on Missouri Avenue, Lea Avenue, Kentucky Avenue and Pennsylvania Avenue, as follows:

(a) On Missouri Avenue the curb lines shall be uniformly 35 feet from the property line;

(b) On Lea Avenue the curb lines shall be uniformly 35 feet from the property line;

(c) On Kentucky Avenue from Alameda Street to 14th Street the curb lines shall be uniformly 35 feet from the property line.

(d) On Pennsylvania Avenue from Alameda Street to 14th Street the curb lines shall be uniformly 35 feet from the property line.

Section 2. That all Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith be, and the same are hereby repealed, and this Ordinance shall be enforced from and after its passage and publication, as required by law.
