AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION THIRTY-SIX ^{of}
ORDINANCE NUMBER THIRTY-THREE OF THE RE-
VISED AND COMPILED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY
OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, PASSED AND APPROVED
MARCH THIRD, 1914.

Be it ordained by the City Council, of the City of
Roswell, New Mexico:

Sec. 1. That Section Thirty-six of Ordinance Number
Thirty-three of the revised and compiled ordinances of the City
of Roswell, New Mexico, passed and approved March third, 1914,
is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 36. "That from and after the taking effect of this
Ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or cor-
poration, to buy, sell or deal in, or to buy or sell for pro-
fit, any second-hand article of any description or character
whatsoever, from any minor under the age of twenty-one years,
without the written consent of the parents or guardian of
such minor, and said person, firm, or corporation so buying,
selling or dealing in any such second-hand article shall keep
a record, in a book, kept solely for that purpose, of any
and every article bought, received or handled by such person
firm or corporation, from or for another, giving the date
any such article was so received, and the name, place of
residence and description of the person from whom said
article was received.

The said book, containing said record so required to be
kept, shall at and during all business hours, be open to
inspection by the Police Officers of the said City of Roswell."

Sec. 2. That all Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances in

conflict herewith are hereby repealed, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days after its publication according to law.
