

ORDINANCE No. 367.

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE KEEPING OF GASOLINE  
WITHIN THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Roswell:

Sec. 1. That all gasoline kept within the City of Roswell, for sale or storage purposes shall be kept in a standard tank at least eighteen (18) inches under ground, with standard pump or other standard apparatus for drawing the same therefrom; Provided, however, That five (5) gallons of gasoline may be kept within any residence or business house, and twenty (20) gallons may be kept within an outhouse situate at least twenty (20) feet from the main dwelling or business house; and, provided further, that the above shall not apply to gasoline kept by private individuals in their garages, situate at least thirty (30) feet from the main dwelling, without the fire limits.

Sec. 2. The Chief of the Fire Department is hereby authorized and directed to inspect all premises, and to report any violations of this ordinance by complaint in the Police Court.

Sec. 3. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than five nor more than fifty dollars for each violation, and each day's violation shall be a separate offense hereunder.
