ORDINANCE NO. 370

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE USE OF THE PAVED STREETS  
OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, AND TO PREVENT THE  
OBSTRUCTION OF THE STREETS OF SAID CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL,  
NEW MEXICO:

Sec. 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to haul any rock, gravel, cinders, or other like substances, over the paved streets of said City, except in a vehicle constructed with a tight metal body so made that such substance may not spill upon said pavement, and so loaded that the same may not be dropped or spilled upon said pavement.

Sec. 2. That it shall be unlawful for any person to throw, spill or otherwise place upon the paved streets of said city any rocks, gravel cinders or other like substances.

Sec. 3. That it shall be unlawful for any person to skate upon the paved streets of said city, and all skating shall be confined to the side-walks of said city within present limits.

Sec. 4. That it shall be unlawful to drive over the paved streets of said city any tractor or other vehicle with wheels or other appliances so constructed as to injure said paving.

Sec. 5. That it shall be unlawful for any person to obstruct the streets <sup>alleys</sup> or sidewalks of said city by placing across the same any wire or other obstruction so as interfere with the free use of such streets and side-walks.

Sec. 6. All persons violating the provisions of the foregoing ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than five dollars nor more than fifty dollars for each offense, or be confined in the county or city jail not less than five nor more than thirty days.
