

ORDINANCE NO. 374

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS NINE AND SIXTEEN OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 317, ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE COVERING THE PRODUCTION, HANDLING, AND DISPOSAL OF MILK, CREAM, AND THE PRODUCTS THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR THE INSPECTION OF COWS, PREMISES, ETC.; AND REQUIRING A LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF MILK, CREAM, AND THEIR PRODUCTS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. ADOPTED DECEMBER 7th, 1915.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL:

Sec. 1. That section nine of ordinance number 317, of the City of Roswell, covering the production, handling, and disposal of milk and cream in the City of Roswell, passed December 7th, 1915, be amended by adding thereto the following section to be known as section 9A. ~~for the purpose of making inspections under section nine.~~

Sec. 9A. For the purpose of making inspections under section nine of this ordinance, the dairy and milk inspector shall use the dairy score card, approved by the United States Department of Agriculture, Bureau of Animal Industry, Dairy Division, and indorsed by the Official Dairy Instructors Association, and the said inspector shall furnish to each dairy inspected a copy of said blank score card.

Sec. 2. That section sixteen of said ordinance number 317 be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 16. For the purposes of this ordinance the term "milk" shall be defined as whole milk, skimmed milk, butter milk, or cream, *except that the provisions of section 12 of this ordinance shall not apply to buttermilk*
