

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 22
OF ORDINANCE NO. 24 OF THE COMPILED
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL,
1914, RELATIVE TO LICENSES.

Be It Ordained By The City Council of the City of Roswell, New Mexico:

Section 1. That Section 22 of Ordinance No. 24 of the Compiled Ordinances of the City of Roswell, 1914 relative to licenses be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "Section 22. Fortune tellers, palmists, etc." All clairvoyants, healers, fortune tellers, palmists, phrenologists, hypnotists, astrologers, spiritualistic mediums and other persons engaged in like occupations within the city of Roswell whereby the past, present or future mental or physical qualifications or characteristics of any person or their adaptability for any occupation is sought to be determined by physical, psychical or other such indicia shall before engaging in such occupation obtain from the Mayor a permit to carry on such occupation, who shall have authority, in his discretion to grant or refuse the same. Upon obtaining such permit the same shall be presented to the City Clerk who shall thereupon issue a license for the carrying on of such occupation within said City upon the payment of a fee of \$25.00 per month in advance. Any person seeking to engage in any such occupation without first complying with the provisions of this Section shall be fined in a sum not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$300.00, or be confined in the city or county jail not less than ten days nor more than ninety days, at the discretion of the judge trying the case.

Section 2. That all laws and parts of laws in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed and said ordinance shall go into effect from and after five days from the date of its publication.
