

ORDINANCE NO. 488

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROTECTING
THE HEALTH AND SANITATION OF THE CITIZENS
OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNSEL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL:

Sec. 1 That from and after the passage of this ordinance all sidewalks, doorways, stairways and windows opening from any and all business buildings and out and on the streets and alleys of said city, shall not be swept or cleaned between the hours of 7 o'clock A. M. and 10 o'clock P. M. of any day.

Sec. 2 That any person, persons, firm or corporation who shall violate this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction before any competent court shall pay a fine of not less than \$10.00 or more than \$100.00 or be confined in the City Jail not less than ten days nor more than thirty days, at the discretion of the court trying said cause.

Sec. 3 That this ordinance shall become of full force and effect five days after its passage and publication as by law provided.
