

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR INTERPRETER IN THE COURT.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Roswell, New Mexico.

Sec. 1. That the Police Judge shall be authorized to appoint an interpreter in the trial of all cases in the Police Court where the services of an interpreter are required. Said interpreter shall be sworn as in other cases in the Justices Court.

Sec. 2. The Police Judge shall tax as costs in each case in which the services of an interpreter are required, the sum of Two Dollars to be paid and collected as other costs in the Police Court.
