

ORDINANCE NO. 408

AND ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICES OF DEPUTY CITY CLERK AND DEPUTY CITY TREASURER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

Par. 1. That from and after the adoption of this ordinance it shall be lawful for the City Clerk to appoint by and with the consent of the Mayor a deputy city clerk, and for the City Treasurer with like consent to appoint a deputy city treasurer, who shall perform such of the duties of said office as may be directed by the said City Clerk and City Treasurer respectively, and with full powers of deputy clerk and deputy treasurer respectively, and the said City Clerk and City Treasurer shall be responsible to the City of Roswell for the actions of said deputy so appointed, and may require of said deputy a bond in such sum as may be fixed by said clerk or treasurer, payable to said clerk or treasurer and conditioned upon the faithful performance of their duties as deputy; provided however, that one and the same person may be appointed to both of said offices
