

ORDINANCE NO. 435

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 380 OF THE  
1914 COMPILED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL,  
N.M. RELATING TO OCCUPATION LICENSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, N.M.

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 380 of the  
Compiled Ordinance of the City of Roswell be amended by adding  
to the list of the occupations therein named the following  
named occupations with the following named licenses taxes therefor.

General Brokers and Commission Merchants .....	\$ 50.00
Gravel and Sand Contractors .....	50.00
Poultry Houses .....	20.00
Cotton Seed Oil Mill .....	100.00
Cotton Compress.....	100.00
Milk Depots and Creameries .....	25.00
Cotton Gins.....	50.00
Swimming Pools.....	20.00
Retail Dealers in Distillate, Crude Oil or Petroleum Products.....	25.00
Operators of Cabs, Taxi Cabs, Drays, Automobiles for Hire, transfer or freighting Companies with or without offices in the City of Roswell, soliciting business within said City. One Vehicle .....	12.00
For each additional vehicle.....	2.50
Public Service Corporations furnishing Electricity for power, light or heat and engaged in other lines of public service .....	150.00

Section 2. That the above licenses fees are fixed upon  
the basis of the estimated average income from said occupations  
within the City of Roswell upon a ratio of \$1.00 for each  
\$1,000.00 of income with a minimum license fee of \$5.00 per  
annum. Any person desiring to contest the amount of said  
licenses upon said basis may file an application for License  
with the City Clerk under the provisions of Sec. 10 of Ordinance  
No. 24 and said license fee shall be fixed as provided by Sec.  
9 of said Ordinance No. 24 upon the basis of \$1.00 for each  
\$1,000.00 income and the City Clerk shall issue licenses  
accordingly.
