

ORDINANCE NO. 446


AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 24 OF ORDINANCE NO. 11 OF THE 1914 COMPILED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, ENTITLED CITY OFFICERS-DUTIES AND POWERS.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. That Section 24 of Ordinance No. 11 of the 1914 Compiled Ordinances of the City of Roswell, entitled City Officers - Duties and Powers, be amended to read as follows:-

That the office of City Police is hereby created. That the Mayor at any regular meeting of the City Council or at any meeting called for that purpose, may appoint one or more City Police, which appointment shall be approved by the City Council. The said Policemen shall each thereupon take the oath of office, give bond in the sum of One Thousand Dollars and with the same terms and conditions as the City Marshal; they shall have the same powers and perform the same duties and their acts shall have the same force and effect as said Marshal. Provided, however, the Marshal shall be Chief of Police.
