

ORDINANCE NO. 454

An Ordinance to amend Section One of Ordinance No. 443, and Section Two of Ordinance No. 438, entitled: AN ORDINANCE TO LICENSE, TAX AND REGULATE EXHIBITIONS, SHOWS AND AMUSEMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Roswell, County of Chaves, State of New Mexico.

Section 1. That Section Number One of Ordinance No. 443 be amended so as to read as follows:

"Section One, LICENSES: Any person, firm or corporation conducting or operating any carnival, show, show, circus or menagerie, or Wild West Show, under canvas tents or otherwise, not in any opera house or theater, within the City of Roswell, before performing or showing therein shall for each day of each show, circus or menagerie, where the same is permitted, obtain from the City Clerk a license therefor, and shall pay for such license the following amounts, to-wit: Where the total cost of the admission of adults, including reserved seat and war tax, shall not exceed fifty cents, the sum of Fifteen Dollars per day; where such total admission exceeds seventy-five cents, the sum of Twenty Dollars per day; where such total admission is in excess of seventy-five cents and does not exceed the sum of One Dollar, Thirty-five Dollars per day; where such total admission is in excess of One Dollar and does not exceed the sum of One Dollar and fifty cents, the sum of One Hundred Dollars per day; where such total admission exceeds One Dollar and fifty cents, and does not exceed Two Dollars, the sum of Two Hundred Dollars per day; where such total admission exceeds Two Dollars, the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars per day. PROVIDING, that no such license shall be issued to any such carnival, show or exhibition where a charge for children over five years of age and under twelve years of age, for general admission and reserved seats, shall be in excess of one-half of the cost of the general admission and reserved seats to adults, and that no charge shall be made for the admission of children under five years of age when accompanied by an adult."

Section 2. That Section No. Two of Ordinance No. 438 be amended so as to read as follows:

"Section 2. LICENSES: That no extra license fee shall be charged for side shows owned, directed and managed by such carnival show, show, circus, menagerie or Wild West Show, provided same is on the same plat of ground or location of the original show."
