

ORDINANCE NO. 470

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING TIME LIMIT FOR THE  
PARKING OF AUTOMOBILES AND OTHER VEHICLES  
ON CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF ROSWELL,  
NEW MEXICO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND MAYOR OF  
THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to park an automobile or other vehicle and leave the same parked for a period longer than one hour between the hours of 10 o'clock A. M. and 6 o'clock P. M. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays and between the hours of 10 o'clock A. M. and 9 o'clock P. M. on Saturdays, on Main Street between the North side of First Street and the South Side of Fifth Street; provided, however, there is excepted the East side of Main Street between Fourth Street and Fifth Street; on Second Street between the East side of Richardson Avenue and the West side of Virginia Avenue; on Third Street between the East side of Richardson Avenue and the West side of Virginia Avenue; on Fourth Street between the East side of Richardson Avenue and the West side of Virginia Avenue; provided, however, there is excepted the North side of Fourth Street between Main Street and Virginia Avenue.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in the sum not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00, or be imprisoned in the City Jail not less than one day nor more than ten days.

Section 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
