

ORDINANCE NO. 481.

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING GENERAL AND SPECIAL  
TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1929-1930.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. That there is hereby levied upon all property, real, personal and mixed, situated within the corporate limits of the City of Roswell, which is subject to taxation for State and County purposes, a tax for general City purposes of five mills on each dollar of the assessed value of said property.

Section 2. That there is hereby levied upon all property, real, personal and mixed, situated within the corporate limits of the City of Roswell, subject to taxation for State and County purposes, for the purpose of paying the interest on the bond issue of May 1st, 1926 (sewer) Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00); on the bond issue of May 1st, 1926 (water) One Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00); on the bond issue of May 1st, 1922 (sewer) Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00); on the bond issue of May 1st, 1922 (street improvements) Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00); on the bond issue of May 1st, 1922 (fire protection) Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00); a special levy of two mills on each and every dollar of the assessed value of the said property.

Section 3. That there is hereby levied upon all property, real, personal and mixed, situated within the corporate limits of the City of Roswell, which is subject to taxation for State and County purposes, for creating a bond sinking fund for the redemption of the various bonds as the bonds may become due, a special levy of one mill upon each and every dollar of the

assessed value of said property.

Section 4. That there is hereby levied upon all property, real, personal and mixed, situated within the corporate limits of the City of Roswell, which is subject to taxation for State and County purposes, for the purpose of paying the pavement assessment against the City of Roswell, on City property adjacent to said pavement, a special levy of one mill on each and every dollar of the assessed value of said property.

Section 5. That the said general and special levies are for the purpose of meeting and defraying the expenses, current and otherwise, of the said City of Roswell for and during the fiscal year of 1929-1930 and to be placed upon the tax rolls of Chaves County, New Mexico for the year 1929, as provided by law.

Section 6. That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five days after its publication and the Clerk of the said City of Roswell is hereby directed to serve a copy of this ordinance upon the Board of County Commissioners of said County for the purpose of having said taxes placed upon the tax rolls of Chaves County, New Mexico.
