

Ordinance No. 504

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1 and 4 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 499 OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL RELATING TO TRAFFIC AND SIGNAL LIGHTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL:

Section 1. That signal lights shall regulate traffic on the intersections of streets and alleys where they are installed. The said signal lights shall show a red light an amber light and a green light. The red light shall be a signal for ~~motor~~ vehicles to come to a stop at the intersections, provided however after coming to a complete stop the ~~motor~~ vehicle can turn to the right into traffic; the amber light shall be shown in the intermission between the flashing of the red light and the green light; the green when shown shall be a signal for the vehicles to proceed.

Section 2. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons operating a vehicle to make a U turn or a left turn on Main Street between first street and fifth street inclusive; except it shall be lawful to make a left turn at the intersection of First and Main Street, at the ~~intersection~~ of second and main street and at the intersection of fifth and main street when the green light is shown.

Section 3. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
