

An ordinance regulating the width of streets and the speed limits within the city of Roswell, New Mexico, upon that part of West Second Street bordering upon and contiguous to Federal Aid Project No. 164-"A".


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO: -

Section I : That the minimum width between curbs on that part of West Second Street that borders on and is contiguous to New Mexico Federal Aid Road Project No. 164-A, shall be thirty six feet, and no curb and gutter, pavement or other street improvement shall be constructed thereon at a lesser width than provided for by this ordinance.

Section II : That the speed limit upon said West Second Street that borders on and is contiguous to New Mexico Federal Aid Road Project No. 164-A shall be not less than twenty-five miles per hour.


Section III : That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect 5 days from and after its publication, according to law.
