

ORDINANCE NO. 514

AN ORDINANCE FIXING A LICENSE TAX UPON  
MARBLE MACHINES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. That every person, firm or corporation owing or operating, or in whose place of business there is placed a machine, shall pay an annual license tax of five dollars (\$5.00) per year or fractional part thereof for each machine used in playing a game with marbles or balls which are shot into holes or pockets placed on the board or machine, and for which a charge of one cent (1¢) is made to play such machine; and shall pay an annual license tax of ten dollars (\$10.00) per year or fractional part thereof for each such machine for which a charge of five cents (5¢) is made to play such machine.

Section 2. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in the sum of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) or more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) or imprisoned for a period of not less than three days nor more than ten days.
