

ORDINANCE NO. 524

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO ACCOMPANY AN  
INTOXICATED PERSON WHO OPERATES A MOTOR VEHICLE  
ON THE STREETS AND ALLEYS OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

Section 1.

It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly  
and willingly accompany an intoxicated person, who is  
operating a motor vehicle upon the streets and alleys of  
the City of Roswell, New Mexico.

Section 2.

Any person upon conviction shall be fined not less  
than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than two hundred  
dollars (\$200.00) or imprisoned for not less than ten days  
nor more than thirty days.
