

ORDINANCE NO. 535

AN ORDINANCE FIXING LICENSE FEES OF  
WRESTLING MATCHES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL,  
NEW MEXICO:

Section 1: Every person, firm or corporation who shall give or conduct performances or entertainments, whether in a room, hall, building, tent or open air, where wrestling matches are allowed and where an admittance is charged, shall, before giving or conducting any such performance or entertainment, obtain a license therefor from the City Clerk and pay for each performance or entertainment a license fee of Seven Dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50).


Section 2: At every such wrestling match the promoter shall furnish sufficient police protection, which shall be under the supervision and direction of the Chief of Police.

Section 3: Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in a sum of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) or more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), or confined in the City Jail for a period of not less than five (5) days nor more than thirty (30) days.

Section 4: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
