ORDINANCE REGULATING AND PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF TRUCKS AND OTHER VEHICLES ON CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF ROSWELL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park any truck, or other vehicle or combinations of vehicles, over eighteen (18) feet in length over all, on Main Street between Walnut Street and Fifth Street; on First Street from Main Street to Richardson Avenue; on Second Street between the City limits on the east and the City limits on the west; on Third, Fourth and Fifth Streets between Virginia Avenue and Pennsylvania Avenue; except for the purpose of loading and unloading, which time shall not exceed fifteen (15) Minutes.

SECTION 2: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park any truck or other vehicle loaded with wood, produce, fruit, livestock, feed or other commodity, except for the purpose of making a delivery or in loading said property or merchandise, on Main Street between First and Fifth Streets; on Second Street between the City limits on the east and the City limits on the west; on Third, Fourth and Fifth Streets between Virginia Avenue and Pennsylvania Avenue.

SECTION 3: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park any truck, automobile or other vehicle on the sidewalks of the City of Roswell for the purpose of loading or unloading.

SECTION 4: Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined in the sum of not less than TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) and not more than TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00), or imprisoned for a period of not less than Three Days (3) or more than Thirty days (30).
