

ORDINANCE NO. 543.

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE TEST FOR BANGS DISEASE TO BE GIVEN TO ALL HERDS BEFORE ANY MILK OR MILK PRODUCTS THEREFROM BE SOLD WITHIN THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL:

SECTION ONE: That the test for Bangs disease of all herds and additions thereto shall be made before any milk or milk products therefrom is sold in the City of Roswell, and at least once every twelve months thereafter by a licensed veterinarian approved by the State Cattle Sanitary Board. Said tests shall be made and any reactors disposed of in accordance with the current requirements approved by the United States Department of Agriculture and the Bureau of Animal Industry for accredited herds.


A certificate signed by the veterinarian shall be evidence of the above test.

SECTION TWO: Any person, firm or corporation selling milk or milk products in the City of Roswell from any herd to which the test for Bangs disease has not been given shall be punished by a fine of not less than TEN DOLLARS nor more than TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS and each day's sale shall constitute a separate offense.


SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall go into effect on and after the 1st day of November 1936.
