

ORDINANCE NO. 549

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 18 OF ORDINANCE No. 544 RELATIVE TO THE POSSESSION, HANDLING, SALE AND INSPECTION OF MEATS IN THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, BY PROVIDING THAT IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL TO POSSESS UNMARKED MEATS UNDER CERTAIN STATED CIRCUMSTANCES.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE

CITY OF ROSWELL:


Section 1. That Section 18 of Ordinance No. 544 be amended by adding thereto the following:

It shall be unlawful for any person selling or offering for sale the meat of any animal mentioned in this ordinance, to have in his possession at his place of business any meat or the flesh of any animal mentioned in this ordinance, unless said animal shall have been slaughtered and inspected in full compliance with the provisions of this ordinance governing the slaughter of animals to be sold for food purposes in the City of Roswell; and, further, unless the stamp of an inspector of the City of Roswell, as in this ordinance provided, shall appear thereon.
