OF ROSWELL, 1939 COMPILATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:


- Section I -


That Section 16-605 of the Compiled Ordinances of  
the City of Roswell, New Mexico, 1939 Compilation, be, and  
the same hereby is, amended to read as follows, to-wit:

"16-605. IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL for any railway  
engineer, conductor, yardmaster, agent, or any  
railroad employee, having charge either per-  
manently or temporarily of any railway engine,  
train, car or cars, to allow, suffer or permit  
any railway engine, car or cars, to remain  
across or upon any street or open road within  
the City limits for a longer period than ten  
minutes at any one time; provided, however,  
that said period shall not exceed four minutes  
from the time that a fire truck or ambulance ap-  
proaches said crossing. Inevitable accident or  
casualty shall be a defense to the violation of  
the provisions of this Section."
