ORDINANCE NO. 607

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 593 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

## SECTION I

That Section I of Ordinance No. 593 of the ordinances of the City of Roswell, New Mexico, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

"There is hereby imposed upon the privilege of all persons, firms or corporations licensed by the Division of Liquor Control of the Bureau of Revenue or other licensing authority of the State of New Mexico for the sale of alcoholic liquors at retail within the City of Roswell annual license taxes in the following amounts, to-wit:

Retailer's License . . . \$2000.00
Dispenser's License . . . \$2000.00
Club License . . . . \$1000.00

The license tax imposed hereby shall be paid in cash or by certified check to the City Clerk of the City of Roswell prior to the sale by any such licensee of alcoholic liquors within said City. Any person holding a retailer's, dispenser's or club license from the Division of Liquor Control of the State of New Mexico and desiring to pay the license tax hereby imposed shall file with the City Clerk of the City of Roswell a duplicate copy of the original application filed by such applicant with the Division of Liquor Control. Said application shall be accompanied by cash or certified check in the amount of the license fee to be paid by applicant. Upon filing of an application as herein provided and payment of the license tax, it shall be the duty of the City Clerk of the City of Roswell to issue a license to such applicant evidencing payment of said license tax in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance."

## SECTION II

That Ordinance No. 593 of the City of Roswell, and all other ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
