

ORDINANCE NO. 629

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING LEFT TURNS BY VEHICLES IN CERTAIN STREET INTERSECTIONS IN THE CITY OF ROSWELL, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL:

SECTION I

IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL for the operator of any vehicle to make a left turn in said vehicle in any of the following street intersections in the City of Roswell, to-wit:

THE intersection of First Street and Main Street.

THE intersection of Third Street and Main Street.

THE intersection of Fourth Street and Main Street.

THE intersection of Fifth Street and Main Street.

SECTION II

Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than Two and No/100 Dollars (\$2.00) and not more than Twenty-five and No/100 (\$25.00) or imprisoned for not more than thirty days or both, in the discretion of the Police Judge of the City of Roswell.


SECTION III
