

ORDINANCE NO. 637

AN ORDINANCE FIXING LIABILITY FOR THE PAYMENT FOR WATER AND OTHER SERVICES FURNISHED BY THE CITY OF ROSWELL AND PROVIDING FOR A DEPOSIT TO SECURE THE PAYMENT THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

SECTION I. That Section 201, Article 2, Chapter XXII, be amended to read as follows:

Section A. That all lessees or renters of property shall, before having water furnished to them by the City of Roswell, first deposit Ten (\$10.00) Dollars with the City Clerk of the City of Roswell, as a deposit to secure the payment of any and all water bills and any other bills due from such lessee or renter to said City of Roswell which may be directed by the Council to be charged against said water account.

Section B. That the person applying for a water meter connection, and in whose name the water account is kept shall be liable for the payment of any and all water bills or other bills or statements for services of whatsoever kind and nature charged to said account by direction of the City Council whether said water account or other services is furnished to and used in whole or in part by the person in whose name the water meter stands, or others.

SECTION II. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
