

ORDINANCE NO. 644

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6, ORDINANCE 605, BY PROVIDING FOR MAXIMUM FARES FOR EACH PASSENGER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL FIRST OBTAINED; AND PROVIDING FOR MAKING AN ENFORCEMENT OF REASONABLE RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE TRANSPORTATION OF, AND PAYMENT OF FARES BY ALL PASSENGERS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO REQUIRE THE PURCHASE IN ADVANCE OF TICKETS OR TOKENS IN REASONABLE QUANTITIES WHENEVER PASSENGERS MAY BE CARRIED ON A FARE OF LESS THAN THE REGULAR SINGLE FARE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL:

Section I.

THAT Section VI, Ordinance No. 605 be amended to read as follows:

"Section VI. The fare or charge for each continuous passage from terminus to terminus shall not exceed ten (10¢) cents for each passenger so carried unless the approval of the City Council of Roswell is first obtained. Policemen and Firemen in uniform shall at all times have the right to free transportation on any of the cars or busses operated under this franchise, and the grantee shall at all times have the right to make and enforce reasonable rules and regulations governing the transportation of, and payment of fares by all passengers, including the right to require the purchase, in advance, of tickets or tokens in reasonable quantity, whenever passengers may be carried on a fare of less than the regular single fare. "
