ORDINANCE NO. 723

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION I, SECTION II,
AND SECTION III OF ORDINANCE NO. 653 OF THE
CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW
MEXICO:

That Section I, Section II and Section III of Ordinance No.
653 of the City of Roswell, be and the same hereby are amended to read
as follows; to wit:

SECTION I

Scope of Ordinance. That all evaporative and refrigerative coolers
using water for a means of extracting heat and lowering temperatures,
on all types of occupancies, residential or otherwise, being located
within the City limits of Roswell, shall come under the scope of this
Ordinance.

SECTION II

Defining Evaporative Coolers. (a) "Evaporative Coolers" are de-
fined as any equipment used for the purpose of lowering temperatures
in an enclosure other than refrigeration, as applied in this ordinance
it covers the specific term evaporative cooling equipment.

(b) "Building lines" means the line established by law beyond
which the building shall not extend, except as specifically provided
by law.

SECTION III

All evaporative coolers within the scope of this ordinance installed
after March 1st, 1957, shall have a re-circulating unit.
