

ORDINANCE NO. 713

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 165, CHAPTER 15, ARTICLE X, DIVISION 2 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO 1952, IMPOSING CERTAIN LICENSE FEES UPON THE USE OF BICYCLES WITHIN THE CITY OF ROSWELL AND, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH, DECLARING THIS ORDINANCE TO BE SEVERABLE AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That Section 165, Chapter 15, Article X, Division 2 of the Code of the City of Roswell, New Mexico 1952 be, and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 165, Application; fee

Application for a bicycle license and license plate shall be made upon a form provided by the City and shall be made to the Chief of Police. An annual license fee of Fifty Cents (\$.50) shall be paid to the City before each license or renewal thereof is granted."

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

That this ordinance is hereby declared to be severable and in the event any part or parts thereof be declared to be invalid, the remaining part or parts thereof shall be and remain in full force and effect.

That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure on the ground of urgent public need, and therefore, upon its final passage approval, shall be recorded in the Book of Ordinances of said City kept for the purpose, authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and the City Clerk, shall be published as provided by law, and shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after such publication.
