

ORDINANCE NO. 741

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7, CHAPTER 12, THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, 1952; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That Section 7, Chapter 12, of the Code of the City of Roswell, New Mexico, 1952, be amended as follows:

"The collection of garbage and refuse from houses, buildings and premises for residential purposes shall be divided into five classes according to the family unit therein. The City Clerk shall collect these garbage fees either through the water department as a separate item on each water bill, or by any other practicable means of collection. The fees shall be assessed against the person in whose name the water meter is listed. Fair and reasonable charges for this residential service shall be and are shown in terms of the dollars and cents in a column under each classification for a calendar month as follows.

Class 1.	Single Family Resident.....	\$1.50
Class 2.	Duplex apartment (where containers are located at same site), each apartment.....	\$1.50
Class 3.	Garage apartment.....	\$1.50
Class 4.	Group housing (three or more houses on same meter), per house.....	\$1.50
Class 5.	Three family apartment or more, per apartment.....	\$1.00

The collection of garbage and refuse from commercial establishments shall be divided into fifteen classes. The collection of fees for the service shall be the same as outlined in Section 8 for the collection of fees for residential service. Fair and reasonable charges for this commercial service shall be and are shown in terms of dollars and cents in a column under each classification for a calendar month as follows:

Class 1.	Retail food establishments (large)...	\$10.00 - \$50.00
Class 2.	Retail food establishments (small)...	\$ 4.00 - \$15.00
Class 3.	Cafes (large).....	\$10.00 - \$20.00
Class 4.	Cafes (small).....	\$ 3.00 - \$10.00
Class 5.	Mercantile establishments.....	\$ 5.00 - \$31.00
Class 6.	Drug stores.....	\$ 4.50 - \$50.00
Class 7.	Tourist Courts & Trailer Camps.....	\$ 4.00 - \$25.00
Class 8.	Industrial plants.....	\$ 7.00 - \$50.00
Class 9.	Filling Stations.....	\$ 1.50 - \$ 7.50
Class 10.	Barber shops and beauty shops.....	\$ 1.50 - \$ 4.00
Class 11.	Theatres and places of amusements...	\$ 7.50 - \$15.00
Class 12.	Hotels.....	\$ 7.50 - \$20.00
Class 13.	Bars and package stores.....	\$ 5.00 - \$15.00
Class 14.	Offices and Office Buildings.....	\$ 3.00 - \$50.00
Class 15.	All others not listed above.....	\$ 3.00 - \$50.00

The City Council shall have the power and authority to set a fair and reasonable charge to cover the service rendered at any place."

2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
