ORDINANCE NO. 790

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING RATES FOR THE USE OF CITY WATER LINES, CITY WATER SYSTEM AND FOR CITY WATER SERVICE FURNISHED: PROVIDING FOR LIEN AND THE FORECLOSURE THEREOF AS PROVIDED BY STATE LAW: REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. There is hereby levied and imposed and there shall be collected from all users of the City water lines and water system, for the use thereof, and for City water service furnished, exclusive of sewer service charges, a monthly service charge to be made on the basis of the amount of water used, according to the following schedule:

For the first 5,000 gals. or less, per 1,000 gals	\$0.31
with a minimum charge of	1.55
For the next 5,000 gals., per 1,000 gals.	0.21
For the next 20,000 gals. per 1,000 gals.	0.16
For all over 30,000 gals. per 1,000 gals.	0.11

a. Any such unpaid charges shall constitute a lien upon the property and may be foreclosed all as provided by State Law.

2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.


3. That this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Roswell, Chaves County, New Mexico, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure on the ground of urgent public need; and therefore, immediately upon its final passage, shall be recorded in the book of ordinances of said City kept for that purpose, authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and City Clerk, shall be published in the Roswell Daily Record, a legal newspaper, published and of general circulation in said City, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days after such publication.



