

ORDINANCE NO. 803A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBPARAGRAPH A. AND B. OF SECTION 1 AND, SECTION 2. OF ORDINANCE NO. 740 OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL: THEREBY INCREASING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ROSWELL CITY RECREATION COMMISSION FROM SEVEN (7) TO TEN (10) MEMBERS: REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That Subparagraph A. and B., Section 1 and Section 2 of Ordinance No. 740 of the City of Roswell be, and the same hereby are, amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 1. Creation, Membership, Appointment, Terms.

A. There is hereby created a Commission to be known as the "Roswell City Recreation Commission", which shall consist of ten (10) members, one of whom shall be a duly elected and qualified member of the City Council; at least one of whom shall be a duly elected and qualified member of the City of Roswell Board of Education, and two of whom shall be women. Said Commission members shall be appointed from residents of the City by the Mayor of the City of Roswell with the approval and consent of the City Council.

B. Initially, the Mayor shall appoint to the Commission four members, for one year; three members for two years and, two members for three years and, the City Councilman so appointed shall serve for a term concurrent with his duly elected term as a member of the City Council. Thereafter, the terms of all Commission members, except the member who is a city councilman, shall be for three years, and until their successors shall be appointed and qualified.

Section 2. Meetings, Quorum, Vacancies. The Commission shall meet at regular intervals and not less than four times annually, and at such regular or specially called meetings as may be deemed fitting and proper. The Chairman, or his designate and five members of the Commission shall constitute a quorum for all regular or specially called meetings. Vacancies occurring in the membership of said Commission by reason of death, resignation, termination of resident in the City, or removal from the Commission for cause, shall be filled by appointment of the Mayor for the unexpired part or portion of the term of the vacant membership, all as provided in Section 1 hereof.


2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.


3. That this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Roswell, Chaves County, New Mexico, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure on the ground of urgent public need; and therefore, immediately upon its final passage, shall be recorded in the book of ordinances of said City kept for that purpose, authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and City Clerk, shall be published in the Roswell Daily Record, a legal newspaper, published and of general circulation in said City, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days after such publication.
