

ORDINANCE NO. 820

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 20-18, ARTICLE I;
AND AMENDING SECTION 36-33 (a). ARTICLE III, OF THE
CODE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, 1962, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL,
NEW MEXICO.

1. That Section 20-18, Article I of the Code of the City of Roswell, New Mexico 1962, be and the same hereby is repealed in its entirety.

2. That Section 36-33 (a), Article III of the Code of the City of Roswell, New Mexico, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows, to-wit:

(a) Residential property. All lessees, renters or occupants of residential property except the legal owner thereof shall, before having water furnished to them by the City, first deposit the sum of fifteen dollars with the City Clerk, as a deposit to secure the payment of all water bills or charges as shall be and become due and owing to the city from such lessees, renters or occupants, accrued or accruing, pursuant to ordinance in such case made and provided or, as directed by the City Council to be charged against such water account.

3. That this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Roswell, Chaves County, New Mexico, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure on the ground of urgent public need and therefore, immediately upon its final passage, shall be recorded in the book of ordinances of said City for that purpose, authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and City Clerk, shall be published in the Roswell Daily Record, a legal newspaper, published and of general circulation in said City, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days after such publication.


