

ORDINANCE NO. 836

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE RESIGNATION
OF CITY OFFICERS OR OTHER EMPLOYEES
UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS AND, REPEALING
ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDI-
NANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL,
NEW MEXICO:

1. That any city officer on a paid status or other person employed by the City of Roswell on a salary basis who shall evidence his intention to be and become a candidate for an elective office, of which office he is not then the lawful incumbent, by entering and duly filing his name as a candidate according to law for such elective office sought, shall resign from any such city office or city employment held by him, such resignation to be and become effective either on or before the date of such filing of his candidacy for the elective office sought.

2. In the event any such person becoming a candidate shall not so resign his office or employment, his becoming a candidate for elective office shall be deemed an election on his part to resign such city office or employment, his salary or compensation shall thenceforth automatically terminate, and he shall cease to perform his prior work or duties.

3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.
