

ORDINANCE NO. 854

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION (b) OF SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 845 OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That subsection (b) of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 845 of the City of Roswell be, and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows, to-wit:


(b) Commercial. Fair and reasonable charges - computation. Procedure for the collection of fees for commercial service shall be the same as that set forth for the collection of fees for residential service. Fair and reasonable charges for such commercial service shall be computed by the City Manager for each separate commercial establishment upon the basis and at the rate of \$12.00 per hour for each hour of loading or proportionate part thereof of each garbage or collection unit, which collection unit shall consist of one vehicle with necessary personnel to operate the same, provided, however, that no garbage collection fee for any such commercial establishment shall be less than \$2.25 per month. From and after approval, ratification and confirmation by the City Council, such schedule of computed collection fees thenceforth shall be and become the duly constituted, subsisting and effective collection fee schedule for commercial establishments within the city.

The City Council shall have the power and authority to set fair and reasonable charges from time to time to cover the service rendered at any place or establishment.

2. That this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Roswell, Chaves County, New Mexico, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure on the ground of urgent public need; and therefore, immediately upon its final passage, shall be recorded in the book of ordinances of said City kept for that purpose, authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and the City Clerk, shall be published in the Roswell Daily Record, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in said City, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days after such publication.
