ORDINANCE NO. 955

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15, ARTICLE III OF ORDINANCE NO. 942; REPEALING SAID SECTION 15, ARTICLE III OF ORDINANCE NO. 942 TITLED "IMPOUNDMENT", TOGETHER WITH ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT OR INCONSISTENT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND, FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That Section 15, Article III of Ordinance No. 942 be, and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 15. Impoundment. It is lawful for the animal warden, his authorized agents and representatives and any police officer to impound any dog found not wearing a dog tag or, any dog reasonably believed to be in violation of any provision of city ordinances whether such dog shall be licensed or unlicensed, tagged or untagged. It is lawful for the animal warden, his authorized agents and representatives to go upon private property in pursuit of any dog sought to be impounded when found running at large in violation of this ordinance.

2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be and become effective on and after January 1, 1974.


3. Severability. Section 15, Article III of Ordinance No. 942, together with all other ordinances, parts of ordinances or sections of the Municipal Code of the City of Roswell in conflict or inconsistent herewith be, and the same hereby are repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or parts of any ordinance heretofore repealed.
