ORDINANCE NO. 958

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1 AND 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 889; PROHIBITING THE TAKING OF GAME FISH FROM ANY WATERS, LAKE OR POND WITHIN CITY OF ROSWELL SPRING RIVER PARK, EXCEPT BY CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 12 YEARS; PROHIBITING WADING, SWIMMING AND/OR BOATING; IMPOSING CERTAIN DUTIES UPON THE DIRECTOR OF CITY PARKS; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT; REPEALING SECTIONS 1 AND 2, ORDINANCE NO. 889, TOGETHER WITH ALL OTHER ORDINANCES, PARTS OF ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE IN CONFLICT OR INCONSISTENT HERewith TO THE EXTENT ONLY OF SUCH INCONSISTENCY, AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

That Sections 1 and 2, Ordinance No. 889 be, and the same hereby are amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Fishing prohibited, except for children under 12 years, Wading, Swimming or Boating PROHIBITED, Violation a misdemeanor. It shall be unlawful for any person:

a. Except children who have not reached their twelfth birthday, to take any game fish by whatever means from any waters, lake or pond within City of Roswell, Spring River Park, and

b. To wade, swim or engage in boating by any means in and upon said waters, pond or lake.

Violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor, punishable upon conviction as provided in Section 6, Chapter 1 of the Code of the City of Roswell, New Mexico.

Section 2. Enforcement, Director of Parks - Duties. It shall be the duty of the Director of city parks to:

a. Enforce the provisions of this ordinance;

b. Post appropriate warning signs in the immediate vicinity of any such park waters giving adequate public notice under penalty of law that:

(1) Such fishing privileges are restricted to children under 12 years of age, and


(2) Wading, swimming and/or boating in or upon said waters, pond or lake is PROHIBITED.

Section 3. REPEALER. Sections 1 and 2, Ordinance No. 889 be, and the same hereby are repealed, together with all other ordinances, parts of ordinances or sections of the Municipal Code in conflict or inconsistent herewith to the extent only of such inconsistency.

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall be and become effective on and after May 20, 1974.
