ORDINANCE NO. 966

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 964 BY REASON OF AN ERRONEOUS DESCRIPTION OF LANDS THEREBY SOUGHT TO BE ANNEXED.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 964 annexing certain lands to the City of Roswell contains an inadvertent error in the description of lands sought to be annexed. This ordinance is duly enacted for the purpose of amending said erroneous description embodied in Ordinance No. 964 adopted on 8 October 1974 and filed for record in the Office of the County Clerk of Chaves County, New Mexico on 17 October 1974 per Receipt No. 93840.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That Ordinance No. 964 and the erroneous description of lands therein be, and the same hereby are amended to read as follows:

The S $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 1, Block 20; the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 2, Block 20; and, the E. 400 ft. of Lot 19, Block 17, Berrendo Irrigated Farms, a subdivision of Chaves County, New Mexico, a copy of which is on file in the office of the County Clerk, Chaves County, New Mexico, not presently within the city limits of Roswell, New Mexico, being 34.4 acres, more or less.
