

ORDINANCE NO. 982

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO AMENDING SECTION 12-7-2 OF THE UNIFORM TRAFFIC ORDINANCE AS ADOPTED BY THE CITY OF ROSWELL, REQUIRING THE USE OF LIGHTS ON MOTORCYCLES, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

That Section 12-7-2 of the Uniform Traffic Ordinance as adopted by the City of Roswell is hereby amended by adding the following paragraphs:

E. It shall be unlawful to operate a motorcycle, motor scooter, or other motorized two or three-wheeled vehicle, excluding wheel chairs, on public property within the corporate limits of the City unless such vehicle shall have both head lamp or light, and tail lamp or light. Such lights, or lamps, shall be lighted at all times, regardless of the time of day or night, and regardless of such conditions as weather, dust, sunlight or clouds, and the availability of other lighting sources, such as street lights.

F. 1. The foregoing provision shall apply notwithstanding the requirements of Section 12-10-1.3 of the New Mexico Uniform Traffic Ordinance.


2. This Ordinance shall be and become effective on and after December 1, 1975.

3. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or sections of the Roswell City Code or the New Mexico Uniform Traffic Ordinance as adopted by the City of Roswell, with the express exception of Section 12-10-1.3 of the Uniform Traffic Ordinance, in conflict herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed from and after December 1, 1975, to the extent only of such conflict or inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance, part or parts of any ordinance, or sections heretofore repealed.


4. If any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of this ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.
