ORDINANCE NO. 984

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 941 OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, LIMITING THE LAND ADJACENT TO PROPOSED ZONING CHANGES UPON WHICH PERCENTAGE OF VALID PROTEST MAY BE BASED, REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT OR INCONSISTENT HEREWITH, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. That Paragraph b. of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 941 of the City of Roswell, New Mexico is hereby amended to read as follows:

b. The land adjacent to and within one hundred (100) feet of the area proposed to be rezoned or otherwise transformed, excluding public rights of way in measuring such one hundred (100) feet.

Section 2. Repealer. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith be, and the same hereby are repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or parts of any ordinance heretofore repealed.

Section 3. Severability. That if any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be and become effective five (5) days after its publication.
