

ORDINANCE NO. 1009

AN ORDINANCE FIXING COMPENSATION FOR THE OFFICE OF MUNICIPAL JUDGE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT OR INCONSISTENT HERewith AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:


1. Commencing with the term of office beginning on March 5, 1978, compensation for the office of Municipal Judge in and for the City of Roswell be, and the same hereby is fixed in the sum of \$900 per month, payable to the duly elected Municipal Judge or his successors incumbent in office according to law in such case made and provided.

2. Ordinance No. 956 and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or parts of any ordinance heretofore repealed.


3. This Ordinance shall be and become effective on and after March 5, 1978.
