ORDINANCE NO. 1012

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A NEW AND INCREASED RATE SCHEDULE FOR MUNICIPAL SERVICES IN MAKING WATER AND SEWER EXTENSION; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 971; REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT OR INCONSISTENT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. Ordinance No. 971 providing for the establishment of rates for water and sewer extensions by the municipal governing body, by resolution, rather than by ordinance is hereby repealed in its entirety.

2. The charge for municipal services in making water and sewer extensions shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per foot of extension plus a One Dollar (\$1.00) per foot assessment for park development for each foot of extension. Except in the event that a dedication of appropriate park land has been recommended by the Planning and Zoning Commission and approved by the City Council, and consented to by the developer, then and in that event only, the Ten Dollar (\$10.00) per foot portion of the extension charge shall be assessed.

3. Repealer: All other resolutions, ordinances, parts of ordinances or sections of the Municipal Code in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed from and after the effective date of this ordinance, to the extent only of such inconsistencies. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinances or parts of any ordinance hereby repealed.

4. Severability: That if any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.


5. Effective Date: This ordinance shall be and become effective on and after March 1, 1978.
