ORDINANCE NO. 1015

AN ORDINANCE FIXING NEW AND INCREASED CHARGES AND NEW AND INCREASED TRADE-IN CREDIT ALLOWABLES APPLICABLE UPON THE PURCHASE OF LARGER WATER METERS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES, PARTS OF ORDINANCES OR PRICE SCHEDULES IN CONFLICT OR INCONSISTENT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Schedule. Purchase Prices and Allowable Credits. The following schedule of water-meter purchase prices and smaller meter credit allowances are hereby established:

3/4"	...	\$110.	...	Credit for Larger Meter.	...	\$ 34.
1"	...	\$175.	...	Credit for Larger Meter.	...	\$ 80.
1 1/2"	...	\$325.	...	Credit for Larger Meter.	...	\$140.
2"	...	\$475.	...	Credit for Larger Meter.	...	\$205.
3" or Larger	-Actual cost of Labor and Material.					

Fire line for sprinkler system or fire hydrant will be provided upon payment of actual cost of labor and materials.

SECTION 2. Repealer. All ordinances, parts of ordinances or price schedules in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.


SECTION 3. Emergency Clause and Effective Date. This ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the inhabitants of the City, and because the City is in great need of the water meter change and credit rate increase, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure on the ground of urgent public need. Immediately upon the adoption of this ordinance by the Governing Body and upon its final passage, this ordinance shall be recorded in the book of ordinances of the City kept for that purpose, authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and City Clerk, and this ordinance shall be published in full in the Roswell Daily Record, a newspaper which maintains an office in and is of general circulation in the City, in accordance with law, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after November 7, 1977, provided such publication occurs at least 5 days in advance of November 7, 1977, or 5 days after such publication if it does not.


